Role:	Masjid Imaam
Reporting to:	Masjid President
Hours:	37 hours
Tenure:	Renewable annually (3 months probationary period)
Salary:	Negotiable depending on experience and qualifications (contribution towards relocation)

Main purpose

To cater for the educational, social and spiritual needs of the community.

To work alongside the Masjid committee in order to plan and carry out initiatives, which will help individuals to understand their deen and their role in the wider community.

To motivate and inspire the community by instilling confidence in them to be successful citizens.

Responsibilities

The Imaam will be expected to carry out the duties listed below.

Core duties

- Cover prayer duties such as regular prayers, Jummah prayer, Eid prayer, funeral prayer and marriage ceremonies.
- To assist in planning and delivering of a Ramadhan programme.
- To hold regular tarbiyyah circles (UKIM members and Public).
- Plan, implement and run educational courses for the community.
- Play an active and leading role in the Madrassah by developing students through teaching and mentoring
- To work closely with the Headteacher to develop the madrassa.
- To teach subjects in the Islamic Sciences, Arabic, Shariah and Quran.
- Provide for the spiritual growth of the youth through educational programs and other activities.

- To work flexibly and undertake any other duties agreed between the post-holder and Neeli Masjid.

Dawah and community outreach

- Participate in community activities that further good interfaith and public relations for Islam and Muslims.
- To help develop the school outreach programme.
- To provide spiritual and educational guidance to new Muslims
